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Del City Selected for Municipal Innovations Award

Del City was chosen for the Municipal Innovations Award for communities with a population greater than 10,000 for their “Get Fit Del City” healthy initiative program at the Oklahoma Municipal League Annual Conference.

The City of Del City created the “Get Fit Del City” program to kick off a healthy city initiative. Del City built a state-of-the-art outdoor fitness court at Patriot Park. They have also implemented a social media page, fitness groups and fully trained fitness ambassadors who will teach classes once a month free of charge to anyone who wants to participate.

“With limited municipal budgets, communities must be creative and find ways to make things happen with grants and partnerships,” said Mike Fina, Executive Director of the Oklahoma Municipal League. “Del City worked to find the funding to make this project a reality for their citizens, and we are proud to present them with this award.”
