3424 Royalwood Circle

The applicant, Caleb Gaskins, is requesting a Special Use Permit (SUP) in order to have an at home Federal Firearms License (FFL) business.

B. Public Hearing

Discussion, consideration, and possible action to approve or deny holding a public hearing on the above-referenced application for specific use permit.

Wendell Kluge made a motion open the public hearing, Mike Streetman seconded the motion.

A neighbor, Stefanie Tiller, resident at 3433 Royalwood, expressed some safety concerns about the FFL dealer in a neighborhood.

The applicant, Caleb Gaskins, resident at 3424 Royalwood, addressed these concerns and commissioner concerns. These concerns included that the business would be by appointment only, there would be no testing of the weapons at the residence, it would only be the applicant working, and that the powder for reloading would be stored in a different area.
