Teamwork + Technology

On June 20, 2025, DCPD'S Flock camera system alerted to a Ford F-250 with an Ohio tag. The vehicle was connected to a known MS13 gang member with cartel ties. DCPD made contact with the FBI, who confirmed the suspect was a person of interest. FBI and ICE agents were actively looking for him. Officers added the vehicle to a local hotlist.

On June 21, 2025, DCPD again received a FLOCK alert on the vehicle. Officers were able to locate the vehicle in the 4300 block of SE 44th. As it turned north on Sunnyslane, Officers conducted a felony stop in the 3900 block of S. Sunnyslane. The suspect was taken into custody without incident.

FBI and ICE agents confirmed Granado was a high-value target, wanted internationally for kidnapping Cuban refugees in Ecuador and forcing them into human trafficking. ICE agents arrived on scene and took custody of the suspect.
