UTILITY BILLING

The utility rate update transition period is complete, and new due dates are now in effect:

- Accounts beginning in **01-32** are due on the **1st of each month**.
- Accounts beginning in **33-62** are due on the **15th of each month**.

Residents, please update your contact information with the Utility Billing Department if your email or phone number has changed. This ensures timely communication regarding emergencies or important account notices.
