BOND ELECTION

On August 25th, Del City residents will have the opportunity to vote on a proposed General Obligation (G.O.) Bond that would fund critical public safety improvements while continuing to invest in the city's future.

The proposed bond package is designed to address the needs of police, fire, and emergency management. These investments will help maintain and enhance the infrastructure and services that residents rely on every day.

The proposed G.O. Bond includes a new fire engine, a hybrid brush rig/rescue vehicle, new police patrol vehicles, and an updated/upgraded outdoor warning system.

Over the coming weeks, residents will have opportunities to learn more about proposed projects, estimated costs, and anticipated community benefits through the City website, neighborhood watch meetings, social media channels and upcoming town hall.

Together, we will continue building a stronger Del City for generations to come.
